THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE ARE NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER BMW WELT.

1. People without proof of being vaccinated or recovered and not provide a matching proof of identity.
2. Anyone with coronavirus symptoms such as a fever, sore throat, muscle/joint pain, cough or shortness of breath.
3. Individuals returning from a risk area in the last 10 days, or a "virus variant area" / "high-risk area" in the last 14 days (definition according to the Robert Koch-Institute) and who are or should be self-isolating.
4. Anyone who has had contact with someone who has been tested positive for coronavirus in the last 14 days and who is or should be self-isolating.

HERE IS WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP.

1. Wash your hands regularly and extremely thoroughly.
2. Please cover your nose and mouth by wearing a surgical mask.**
3. Maintain a minimum distance of 1.5 m from other people.
4. Please cough or sneeze into your elbow.
5. We are legally obliged in certain areas to register our guests to follow up possible chains of infection. This measure is subject to the GDPR.
